



Discipline Policy

Fatima Tricha Payan Large Family Child Care ("LFCCH") provides an environment that gives children the opportunity to learn, explore and succeed with the use of praise and positive reinforcement to minimize the need for disciplinary action. Reasonable expectations help keep conflicts to a minimum in an environment that is stimulating and nurturing.

Methods of Discipline

1. Positive discipline, which shall include the following:
 - a. using positive statements to communicate with children.
 - b. encourage children to use their own words and solutions in order to resolve their own interpersonal conflicts.
 - c. explain to the children the behavior that is expected from them.
2. Distraction: Change the child's focus to an acceptable activity without confronting the inappropriate behavior.
3. Redirect: Anticipate problems and intervene beforehand with an appropriate solution.
4. Time out:
 - b. Time out should not exceed more than 1 minute for each year of age of the child.
 - c. Time out is used for the purpose of allowing the child to regain control, and then join the group back.

However, should a child become physical and/or aggressive toward his/her peers or teachers, he/she will be removed from the group and parents will be called for immediate pick up.
