Risk Management and Emergency Procedure

In case of a medical emergency:

Parents and persons listed on the emergency contact form will be contacted immediately. If the emergency is extreme 911 will be called as well. If the child is taken to a medical facility by 911, you and/or your emergency contact persons will be notified of the medical facility location. Please refer to the Parent’s Handbook for further details.

In case of fire:

We practice fire drills once a month to prepare the children for an evacuation in case of fire or any other emergency that would require an evacuation to a different site. Parents and/or emergency contact persons will be notified as soon as possible of the situation and alternate location for them to join us or wait for us at the alternate location close to LFCCH.

In case of an undetermined emergency where it is judged that the LFCCH is no longer a safe place, parents and/or your emergency contact persons will be notified to pick up the child at an agreed upon designated location.

Unexpected tornado warning and severe weather:

Children and staff will take refuge in the safest place in the premises. Children will be advised to cover their heads and faces and stay put until it is safe to leave. Parents and/or emergency contact persons will be notified as soon as possible of the situation and pick up arrangements.

In case of Hurricane and Tropical Storm:

LFCCH will follow Miami Dade Public Schools and/or any other local authority’s instructions and schedule provided via text, local radios, and TV stations.
